**Job Title:** Choir Pianist/Organist

## **Principal Function:**

The Church Pianist/Organist is a committed individual who provides musical accompaniment for scheduled worship services and other opportunities in support of the music ministry of the church. Having a pivotal role in the musical life of the church, this individual is a strong team player, being a full partner with the Pastor and the Minister of Music of the Calvary Baptist Church.

## **Summary of Duties:**

To provide musical accompaniment during Sunday worship, revivals, and other worship opportunities. Also, to rehearse with the choirs and guest soloist(s).

## **Responsibilities:**

1. To play for Sunday morning worship services and upon request of the Pastor or Minister of Music (and upon availability).
2. Flexibility to play in blended style services that include all types of worship music.
3. Attend mandatory choir/band rehearsals
4. To be under the direction and supervision of the Minister of Music
5. Maintain an accurate account of organ needs and maintenance and notify the Minister of Music.

## **Accountability:**

The Organist is accountable to the Minister of Music as head of the Worship and Music Ministry of the church and Pastor. This individual will need to notify the Minister of Music a minimum of three weeks prior to planned absences (preferably as soon as known) to allow for scheduling of a substitute organist. An annual performance review will be done.

## **Minimum Qualifications:**

- A. Graduate of a four (4) year college with a concentration in music or an equivalent combination of training and experience
- B. Christ like attitude and cooperative spirit
- C. Spirit of humility as well as good interpersonal skills

## **Salary:**

Negotiable, consistent with candidate's education, experience and skill level.

**Works under the supervision of the Pastor and Minister of Music. Performs all duties as requested by the Pastor, Minister of Music and Leadership Ministries.**
